WELCOME

The 9th Annual Peterbilt 250 will begin Sunday, September 6th at 2:00 pm.

RESERVED SEATING

Reserved seating will continue again for the 2009 Peterbilt 250. If you were a reserved seat holder in 2008, you will receive a letter with an order form, indicating the seat you held last year. Starting on July 2nd reserved tickets can be renewed by returning the form as outlined in your letter or by calling the RACELINE at (506) 454-7223 or at the Speedway on race day. If you did not hold reserved seats last year and would like to take advantage of this service in 2009, starting on July 20th reserved seat tickets can be purchased by calling the RACELINE at (506) 454-7223 or at the Events Office at the Speedway on race day. Reserved seating tickets will be sold at an additional cost of only \$10 per ticket. (ie Sunday General Admission Grandstand Ticket will be \$40, Sunday Reserved Seating Grandstand Ticket will be \$50) Check out the website for complete details and pricing, www.speedway660.com.

Tickets for SPEEDWEEKEND will be available through the race line (454-7223) or 1-888-6427-250. **Please note: the sale will be processed on your credit card when the order is placed.** Tickets will be available for pickup on race days beginning July 25th. No advance tickets will be mailed.

RESERVING YOUR 2008 CAMPSITE FOR 2009

Again in 2009, a minimum of one ticket will need to be purchased on arrival at the track or over the phone in order to register a campsite. We are continuing this as an attempt to ensure that it is the race patrons that have access to the camping available.

The reservation hotline will be opened to 2008 Campers on July 2nd, 2009. If you wish to reserve a spot, we again encourage you to please fax, mail, or email us the details along with the enclosed. If you require additional spots, open reservations will begin July 20th, 2009.
